4. Bids without supporting documents, undertaking, valid documentary evidence and bids not conforming to terms and conditions given in the Tender Document will be liable for rejection.
5. Procurement will be made as per PPRA rules 2014.
6. Bids received after due time and date or bids without Bid Security in shape of CDR/Pay Order or Bid Security less than required amount shall be summarily rejected.
7. The sealed bids complete in all respect as detailed in bidding documents must reach in the office of Project Director (Building and Works) on or before 19-12-2022 until 11:00 A.M. The proposal will be opened on 19-12-2022 at 11:30 A.M. in the presence of the bidders or their representatives who make them present.

1. INVITATION TO THE BID

Bids/Tenders are invited, for Purchase of Library Books / Text Books / Reference Books to strengthening the collection of Punjab Tianjin University of technology Library, Lahore from NTN / STRN Registered firms.

2. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

- 2.1. Procurement will be made under Punjab Procurement Rules (PPRA) 2014- amended till date.
- 2.2. It will be clearly understood that the Terms and Conditions mentioned in this document are intended to be strictly enforced.
- 2.3. Bidders must ensure that they submit all the required documents indicated in the Tender / Bid Documents at the time of opening of Technical Bids and no request for submission of missing documents will be entertained after opening of the Technical Bids.
- 2.4. Bids without supporting documents i.e. fully prepared samples, undertaking, valid documentary evidence, and bids not conforming to terms and conditions given in the Tender Document will be liable for rejection. Moreover, bids received after due time and date and bids without Bid Security in shape of CDR or CDR less than required amount or Bid Security in shape of Cheque or Cross Cheque shall be rejected.
- 2.5. Tender Document duly signed and stamped by the Project Director Office will be accepted for the Tender.
- 2.6. PTUT shall not pay any security deposit or advance payment.
- 2.7. Contract will be made between PTUT and company on judicial paper of 0.25% of Contract value that will be provided by the successful bidder.
- 2.8. Quoted Items must be legally imported in Pakistan after paying all taxes. (where applicable)
- 2.9. Any point which is not mentioned in the term and conditions contained in the bidding documents Shall be decided in the light of the provisions laid down in Punjab PPRA rule 2014 amended till date.

2.10. Mode of Advertisement:

As per Rule 12(1) the advertisement is being placed on the website of PPRA Punjab (www.ppra.punjab.gov.pk)

2.11. Type of Open Competitive Bidding

As per Rule No. 38(2)a, Single stage two envelope procedure shall be followed with details given below:

2.11.1. The bid shall comprise of a single package containing two separate envelopes.

Each envelope shall contain separately the financial proposal and the technical proposal;

2.11.2. The envelopes shall be marked as “**FINANCIAL PROPOSAL**” and “**TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**” in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion;

2.11.3. Initially, only the envelope marked “**TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**” shall be opened; The envelope marked as “**FINANCIAL PROPOSAL**” shall be retained in the custody of procuring agency without being opened;

2.11.4. The Purchaser shall evaluate the technical proposal under **PPRA Rule # 32** and in a manner prescribed in this document, without reference to the price and reject any proposal which does not conform to the specified requirements as listed in said Sections. During the technical evaluation no amendments in the technical proposal shall be permitted;

2.11.5. The financial proposals of technically qualified bidders shall be opened publicly at a time, and venue announced and communicated to the bidders in advance;

2.11.6. After the evaluation and approval of the technical proposal the procuring agency, shall at a time within the bid validity period, publicly open the financial proposals of the technically accepted and qualified bids only. The financial proposal of bids found technically non-responsive shall be returned un-opened to the respective bidders.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

3. Necessary Documents Requires with Proposal / Bid

- i. The proposal will comprise the following documents. Each document must be signed and stamped by the Authorized Representative of the Bidder:
 - a) Covering letter for Technical Proposal printed on company's letter head (Specimen at **Annex-A**)
 - b) Duly filled in profile of the firm/company (Specimen at **Annex – B**)
 - c) Evidence of at least two (02) years' relevant experience (**Annex – C**)
 - d) Copy of NTN / STRN Registration Certificate
 - e) Affidavit/Undertaking of Rs. 100 Stamp Paper (Specimen at **Annex - D**)
 - f) Covering letter for Financial Proposal (**Annex-E**)
 - g) Tender Price Schedule for Books (**Annex-F**)
 - h) Original CDR of Bid Security / Earnest money amounting to Rs. 29,500/-

4. EXAMINATION OF THE TENDER DOCUMENT

The bidder/Tenderer is expected to examine the Tender Document, including all terms and conditions.

5. AMENDMENT OF THE TENDER DOCUMENT

- 5.1.** The Procurement Committee of Punjab Tianjin University Library, at any time prior to the deadline for submission of the Tender, at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by the Bidder(s), amend the Tender Document, on any account, for any reason. All amendment(s) shall be part of the Tender Document and binding on the Bidder(s).
- 5.2.** The Purchaser shall notify the amendment(s) in writing to the prospective Tenderers/Bidders.
- 5.3.** The Purchaser may, at its exclusive discretion, amend the Tender Document to extend the deadline for the submission of the Tender, in which case all rights and obligations of the Purchaser and the Tenderers previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

6. TENDER PRICE

- 6.1. The quoted price shall be:
 - 6.1.1. best / final / fixed and valid until completion of all obligations under the Contract i.e. not subject to variation / escalation;
 - 6.1.2. in Pak Rupees;
 - 6.1.3. inclusive of all taxes, duties, levies, insurance, freight, etc.;
 - 6.1.4. Including all charges up to the delivery point at Punjab Tianjin University of Technology, Lahore.
- 6.2. If not specifically mentioned in the Tender(s), it shall be presumed that the quoted price is as per the above requirements.
- 6.3. Where no prices are entered against any item(s), the price of that item shall be deemed be free of charge, and no separate payment shall be made for that item(s).

7. VALIDITY PERIOD OF THE BID

- 7.1. Validity period of the bids shall be 90 days.
- 7.2. In exceptional circumstances, the Procurement Committee of Punjab Tianjin University may ask the Bidders for an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses shall be made in writing. A bidder accepting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its tender.

8. BID SECURITY

- 8.1. Bidder will submit Bid Security drawn in the name of Treasurer Punjab Tianjin university of Technology in shape of CDR with details given below:

- 8.2. Cheque or Cross Cheque shall not be accepted at all.
- 8.3. The amount submitted as Bid Security shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders after the decision for the award of the said tender.
- 8.4. The Bid Security of Successful Bidder(s) may be converted as part of the Performance Guarantee for successful execution of the work.

- 8.5. Subject to the award of contract, the Bid Security in form of CDR shall be returned to successful bidder against submission of Performance Guarantee.
- 8.6. If the Bid Security is found less than the required amount, the bid will be rejected irrespective of the rates and the stage of the bid process.
- 8.7. The Bid Security may be forfeited if a Bidder:
- a) Fails to furnish Performance Security.

8.8. **BID PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION**

The Tender shall be filed in / accompanied by the prescribed Forms, Annexes, Schedules, Drawings, Documents, Brochures, Literature, etc. which shall be completely filled in, stamped and signed by the Tenderer or his Authorized Representative. In case of copies, photocopies may be attested.

- 8.9. The Bids/Tenders should be submitted in two parts (1) **Technical Proposal** and (2) **Financial Proposal**. The Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal shall be submitted in separate covers.

8.10. **TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**

The Technical Proposal will enable the Procurement Committee to evaluate whether the bidder is technically competent and capable of executing the order and the specifications offered by the bidder meet the ones given in the Tender/Bid Documents. Only those bids which qualify in the technical stage will be eligible for the Financial Proposal opening. The Financial Proposals of bidders who failed in the Technical stage will not be opened.

- 8.11. The Technical Proposal form as given in the Bid/Tender Document shall be filled, signed and stamped in all pages. The Procurement Committee will not be responsible for the errors committed in the bids by the bidders.
- 8.12. The Technical Proposal should not strictly contain any Price/Cost indications as such otherwise the bids will be summarily rejected.
- 8.13. The Bidder should quote only one brand/model/make of each item.
- 8.14. Samples of items mentioned in the Schedule of Requirement must be provided at the opening of the Technical Bids.

8.15. Technical Evaluation Form:

FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

8.16. The Financial Proposal of the bidder shall also include the price break up of taxes/duties. All taxes/duties as applicable shall be responsibility of the bidders.

8.17. The cost quoted by the bidder shall be kept firm and unchanged for a period specified in the Bid/Tender Documents from the date of opening of the bids. The bidder shall keep the price firm/unchanged during the period of Contract including during the period of extension of time if any.

8.18. The quoted price will be inclusive of all taxes, duties and freight (transportation charges), etc.

8.19. Sealing the Bid

8.19.1. The Technical Proposal shall be placed in a separate cover (**Envelope-A**) and sealed appropriately. The Technical Proposal cover shall be marked as “**Technical Proposal for PURCHASE OF LIBRARY BOOKS / TEXT BOOKS / REFERENCE BOOKS**”

8.19.2. The Financial Proposal (**Envelope-B**) shall contain rates of item quoted by the bidder. The Financial Proposal cover shall be marked as “**Financial Proposal for PURCHASE OF LIBRARY BOOKS / TEXT BOOKS/ REFERENCE BOOKS FOR PUNJAB TIANJIN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY.**”

8.19.3. Out Cover: The Technical Proposal cover (Envelope-A) and Financial Proposal cover (Envelope B) shall then be put in a single outer envelope and sealed. The outer cover shall be marked as “**BID FOR PURCHASE OF LIBRARY BOOKS / TEXT BOOKS/ REFERENCE BOOKS FOR PUNJAB TIANJIN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY.**”

8.20. Mode of Submission of Bids

8.20.1. The Bid should be addressed to “Registrar office Punjab Tianjin

University of Technology Township, Lahore” and submit at , Punjab Tianjin University of Technology, Lahore by hand / Courier should reach last date till 11.00 a.m.

8.20.2. The Bids received after Due Date and Time or Unsealed or incomplete or submitted by Fax or Email will be summarily rejected.

9. MODIFICATION/WITHDRAWAL OF THE TENDER

9.1. The Bidder may, by written notice served on the Purchaser, modify or withdraw the Tender after submission of the Tender, prior to the deadline for submission of the Tender.

9.2. The Tender, withdrawn after the deadline for submission of the Tender and prior to the expiration of the period of the Tender validity, shall result in forfeiture of the Tender Security.

10. BID OPENING

10.1. Technical Proposal Opening

The bid's outer cover and Technical Proposal cover will be opened by the Procurement Committee of Punjab Tianjin University of Technology on the date and time as specified in the Tender Notice / Bid Data Sheet. The bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders who choose to be present. A maximum of two representatives for each bidder would be allowed to attend the Bid Opening.

10.2. Suppression of facts and misleading information

10.2.1. During the bid evaluation, if any suppression or misrepresentation of information is brought to the notice of the Procurement Committee, the Committee shall have the right to reject the Bid and if it happens so after selection of the Bidder, the Procurement Committee may terminate the Contract or award of the Contract or further processing of the Bid as the case may be and that will be without any

compensation to the Bidder and the Bid Security/Performance Guarantee, as the case may be, shall be forfeited.

- 10.2.2.** It is the Bidder's responsibility to prove the Bidder's requisite qualification, experience and capacity to undertake the project to the entire satisfaction of the Procurement Committee, in failing which the Bid may be rejected.

11. PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

- 11.1.** In the preliminary Examination the Procurement Committee will check that the bidder has attached all the required supporting documents and samples. The Procuring Agency shall examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether the required documents have been furnished and properly signed, and whether the bids are generally in order
- 11.2.** In the financial bids (at the time of opening the financial proposal) the arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected. If the Bidders/Suppliers do not accept the correction of the errors, its bid shall be rejected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.

12. DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIVENESS OF THE BID

- 12.1.** The Purchaser shall determine the substantial responsiveness of the Tender to the Tender Document, prior to the Tender evaluation, on the basis of the contents of the Tender itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. A substantially responsive Bid is one which:
- 12.1.1.** Meets all the mandatory requirements of the Technical evaluation criteria.;
 - 12.1.2.** meets the delivery period / point for the Goods / the Services;
 - 12.1.3.** is accompanied by the required Bid Security;

- 12.1.4. is otherwise complete and generally in order;
- 12.1.5. Conforms to all terms and conditions of the Tender Document, without material deviation or reservation
- 12.1.6. which offers one Brand/Model/Make for each item (which does not contain any option)
- 12.2. A material deviation or reservation is one which affects the scope, quality or performance of the Goods or limits the Purchaser's rights or the Bidder's obligations under the Contract.
- 12.3. The Tender determined as not substantially responsive shall not subsequently be made responsive by the Tenderer by correction or withdrawal of the material deviation or reservation. However, the Purchaser may waive off any minor non-conformity or inconsistency or informality or irregularity in the Tender.
- 12.4. The items for which samples are required, shall only be considered if samples provided by the bidders are as per given specifications having top quality material, workmanship and are approved by the Procurement Committee.
- 12.5. Low quality samples will not be accepted.
- 12.6. If the bidder does not provide samples of items then rates of those items will not be included in the Comparative Statement.

13. **TECHNICAL EVALUATION CRITERIA**

Technical Bids will be evaluated on the basis of following criteria and Financial Bids of only those bidders will be opened who have fulfilled the criteria:

The bidder must provide Verifiable documentary proof against all the mandatory requirement along with the Technical Proposal and no document will be received or considered after opening of the Technical Proposal.

It is mandatory to fulfill above stated requirements for all bidders. Any bidder not fulfilling above criteria will be considered as non- responsive bidder and will not be taken into consideration for Financial Bid Opening/Evaluation and will stand rejected.

14. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL EVALUATION

14.1. Technically qualified/successful bidder(s)/Tenderer(s) shall be called for opening of the Financial Proposal(s). The Financial Proposals will be opened in the presence of the Bidders at the time and venue indicated by the Purchaser accordingly. The technically Eligible/Successful Bidder(s)/Tenderer(s) or their authorized representatives against each Lot shall be allowed to take part in the Financial Proposal(s) opening against their relevant Lot(s).

14.2. Financial Proposal evaluation will be conducted under the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014. The Price evaluation will include all duties, taxes and expenses etc. In case of any exemption of duties and taxes made by the Government in favor of the Purchaser, the contractor shall be bound to adjust the same in the Financial Proposal.

15. REJECTION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE TENDER/BID

15.1. The Purchaser shall have the right, at his exclusive discretion, to increase / decrease the quantity of any or all item(s), under PPRA Rules 2014 without any change in unit prices or other terms and conditions, accept a Tender reject any or all tender(s), cancel / annul the Tendering process at any time prior to award of Contract, without assigning any reason or any obligation to inform the Tenderer of the grounds for the Purchaser's action, and without thereby incurring any liability to the Tenderer and the decision of the Purchaser shall be final.

15.2. The Tender / bid shall be rejected if:

15.1.1. It is substantially non-responsive; or

- 15.1.2. The bidder **does not meet any of the mandatory criteria mentioned in** Clause No. 15; or
- 15.1.3. It does not contain the documentary proof against any of the mandatory criteria mentioned in Clause No. 15; or
- 15.1.4. The bidder does not attach Bid Security in Shape of CDR
- 15.1.5. The bid security is not attached or it is less than the required amount; or
- 15.1.6. The bid is incomplete, conditional, alternative, late; or
- 15.1.7. The Bidder submits more than one Bids against one Tender; or
- 15.1.8. the Bidder tries to influence the Tender evaluation / Contract award; or
- 15.1.9. The Bidder engages in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the Contract award; or
- 15.1.10. There is any discrepancy between bidding documents and bidder's proposal
i.e. any non-conformity or inconsistency or informality or irregularity in the submitted bid; or
- 15.1.11. the Bidder submits any financial conditions as part of its bid which are not in conformity with tender document.
- 15.1.12. The items for which the bidder quotes more than one rates will not be accepted and such items will not be included in the comparative statement.

16. **CONTACTING THE PROCURING AGENCY**

- 16.1. No Bidder shall contact the Procurement Committee of Punjab Tianjin University of Technology on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time the Contract is awarded.
- 16.2. Any effort by a Bidder to influence the Procuring Agency in its decisions on bid evaluation, bid comparison, or Contract Award will disqualify the bidder and rejection of the bid. Canvassing by any Bidder at any stage of the Tender evaluation is strictly prohibited.

17. **ANNOUNCEMENT OF EVALUATION REPORT**

The Procuring Agency shall announce the results of bid evaluation in the form of a report for acceptance or rejection of bids at least ten days prior to the award of Contract.

The report shall be made available on PPRA website.

18. **PAYMENT OF PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE (PG)**

18.1. The Successful Bidder(s) will be required to remit the Quality assurance guarantee/ Performance Guarantee equivalent to 05% of the value of the contract price. The PG should be submitted in the form of Cash Deposit Receipt (CDR) drawn in favor of “Punjab Tianjin University of Technology” as unconditional Guarantee, valid until satisfactory completion of the entire supply of goods as per contract / Supply Order.

18.2. The Performance Guarantee will be forfeited if the Successful Bidder withdraws the Bid during the period of Bid validity specified in the Bid Documents or if the Bidder(s) fails to sign the contract.

19. **REFUND OF BID SECURITY (BS)**

The Bid Security (BS) of the Successful Bidder may be adjusted towards Performance Guarantee payable by the firm. If the successful Bidder(s) submits Performance Guarantee for the stipulated value in full by way of Cash Deposit Receipt (CDR) and/or Bank Guarantee, the BS will be refunded. The BS of the unsuccessful Bidder will be refunded on the written request of the Bidder. The Bid Security of the successful bidder shall be released upon his request provided the bidder submits five (05) percent Performance Guarantee in the shape of CDR.

20. **REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES BY THE PROCURING AGENCY**

20.1. Any bidder feeling aggrieved by any act of the procuring agency after the submission of his bid may lodge a written complaint concerning his grievances not later than 10 days after the announcement of the bid evaluation report.

20.2. The committee shall investigate and decide upon the complaint within fifteen days of the receipt of the complaint.

20.3. Mere fact of lodging of a complaint shall not warrant suspension of the procurement process.

21. **GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT / SUPPLY ORDER**

- 21.1 The Tender evaluation/ Purchase Order will be awarded to Technically Qualified Bidder (s) who quoted and win lowest price of that individual Title/Books.
- 21.2 The Procurement Committee shall issue Supply Order or sign a Contract with the Successful bidder who has submitted the Performance Guarantee.
- 21.3 The successful bidder (s) will bound to supply all books quoted and having respective work order.

22

DELIVERY OF ITEMS

- 22.1 Punjab Tianjin University of Technology, Lahore shall purchase library books / text books according to allocation of Budget only. Preference should be given to Purchase latest editions / books.
- 22.2 Delivery Period will be **60days** after issuing Purchase Order. Selected Publisher / Vendor shall be responsible to complete the job in time.
- 22.3 The Supplier will be responsible for **Delivery of Books** at following location:

- 22.4 The supplier will bear all costs associated with the preparation, delivery and installation of the Items and the Purchaser will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs. The supplier will make such arrangements to ensure safe delivery of goods. Any damage sustained during transportation / delivery will be rectified by the supplier at his cost.

23.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

- a. When the supplier fails to deliver or install the goods or both within the time period specified in the contract, the Procurement Committee may, without prejudice to any other remedy it may have under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, If the Supplier fails to deliver Books within 30 Days 05 % shall be charged on work order amount. For More than 30 days on late delivery of Books 10% shall be charged on work order amount.
- b. The Successful Bidder will be responsible to provide the delivery, delivery Challan

and Bill within the delivery period in order to avoid Late Delivery Charges.

24. **INSPECTION AND TESTS**

29. **FORCE MAJEURE**

Majeure means an act of nature or an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence directly or indirectly purporting to misplanning, mismanagement and/or lack of foresight to handle the situation. Such events may include but are not restricted to acts of the Procuring Agency in its sovereign capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, earthquakes, strikes, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes. Majeure event.

30. **TERMINATION FOR INSOLVENCY**

In this event, termination shall be without compensation to the Supplier, provided that such termination shall not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or shall accrue thereafter to the Parties.

31.3 In case arising of any dispute between the procuring agency and the contractor after the work order, the dispute should be resolved through the representators of both parties otherwise the decision of Vice Chancellor will prevail over the version of both parties

32. **FORFEITURE OF PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

31.1 If the Contractor fails / delays in performance of any of the obligations, under the Contract / violates any of the provisions of the Contract / commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of the Contract the Purchaser may, without prejudice to any other right of action / remedy it may have, forfeit Performance Security of the Contractor.
